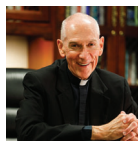
1. Explain MAID's purpose, protocols, and safeguards.

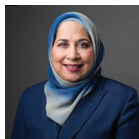

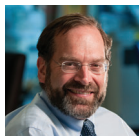
